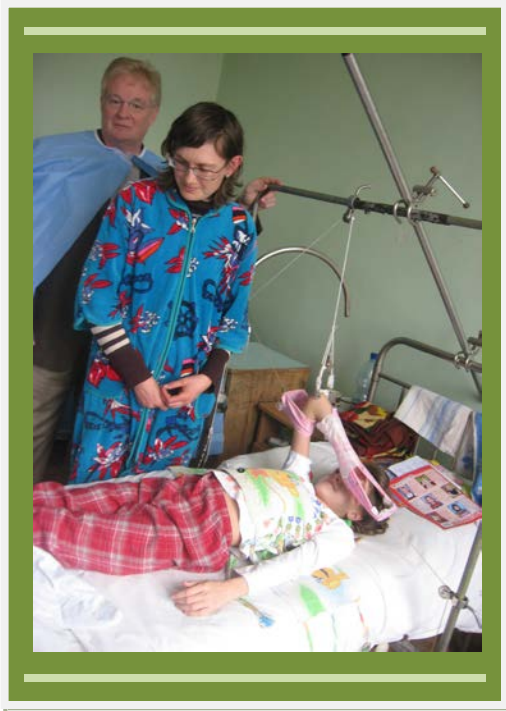


# PRESS RELEASE

The purpose of this mission trip was to provide medical relief in areas where healthcare is limited or difficult to obtain. Dr. Dewey and the other participating physicians successfully treated fifteen surgical patients with 21 total surgical procedures performed during the week, as well as numerous patient/parent consultations along the way. Furthermore, they proved triumphant in negotiations with the Ukrainian Rotary Club for sponsorship,

establishment of an American-Ukrainian lecture circuit in the university & establishment of a children's diabetic management program.
